Analysis Group Repeats in *Globe* 100's "Top Places to Work"

Boston, November 8, 2011 — **Analysis Group**, the largest privately held economic consulting firm in the country, has been named one of the top places to work in Massachusetts for the fourth consecutive year. The firm was ranked 12th among companies with 250 or fewer employees in the state. The "**Top Places to Work**" survey, published annually by *The Boston Globe*, gathered input from employees in about 250 participating companies across the commonwealth.

The "Top Places to Work" **survey** recognizes the most progressive companies in the commonwealth based on employee opinions about company leadership, compensation and training, diversity/inclusion, career development, family-friendly flexibility, and values and ethics. Private companies and nonprofits, as well as publicly held businesses, were included in the analysis. The rankings are based on survey information collected by Workplace Dynamics, an independent firm specializing in employee engagement and retention.

"I think this award reflects the committed, consistent approach we have taken over the years to making Analysis Group a great place to work," said President and CEO **Martha S. Samuelson**. "We have worked hard, across all 10 of our offices, to maintain a strong corporate culture focused on work rigor, respect for the individual, and collaboration."

In the article "**The Best People for the Job**," which accompanied the survey results, Ms. Samuelson and several other executives shared their techniques for finding and retaining talented people. "We spend an enormous amount of time on mentoring," she said. "People are brought in to immediately think that feedback is your friend. It's meant to make you successful, not label you. I think that people feel like their colleagues are looking out for them. They're trying to make them get better at skills that have a value in the marketplace."

Earlier this year, Analysis Group, Inc. was named the **ninth-best consulting firm in the country** to work for by Vault.com, based on input from consultants. This is the second year in a row that the firm has appeared in the Vault top 10.

To qualify for the *Globe's* "Top Places to Work" survey, a company must have more than 100 employees in Massachusetts. The rankings are composite scores calculated purely on the basis of employee responses.

Analysis Group provides economic, financial, and business strategy consulting to leading law firms, corporations, and government agencies. The firm has more than 500 professionals, with offices in Boston, Chicago, Dallas, Denver, Los Angeles, Menlo Park, New York, San Francisco, Washington, D.C., and Montreal.
